The Shokudo

Block Party Premiere

The Shokudo's Block Party Premiere at the VJCC! Sunday, September 22nd, 2024 By Michael Murata, producer

Even if you knew what the "The Shokudo" is or have watched "The Shokudo Series", you might have been confused about what this "block party" event at the VJCC was going to be like and had no idea what to expect. And no one would blame you. We hardly knew ourselves! By the time we fully committed to holding an event at the VJCC, there were twelve weeks left and the race to organize was on.

Originally, "The Shokudo" was just a tool shed along the side of the Okeya house, but with the help of his father Butch Okeya, Jon Kenzo Okeya turned it into a little izakaya bar à la "Midnight Diner" with the intention of feeding his friends using his newly developing interest in Japanese cooking. Meanwhile, I met with Jon's longtime friend and VJCC historian Luke Uyeda to come up with an engaging virtual program for the Japanese American community during the pandemic when most major events were postponed if not outright cancelled. Luke and I pretty quickly settled on using food as a vehicle for exploring our Asian- and Japanese-American identity with Jon as our host and a few weeks later, we were filming the first episode of what would become "The Shokudo Series".



Just two short years into our project, we were floored by the positive feedback we were receiving for our video series. Along with Luke's unmatched ability to create stunning visuals and Jon's disarming curiosity, viewers of our episodes resonated with the stories that we were finding to accompany the dishes we make and eat at every potluck. As pandemic restrictions began lifting and the community felt more comfortable gathering in large groups, we wanted to bring the experience of being at "The Shokudo" to more people hoping that the conversations we have on screen would translate to reality in a way that we could see in front of us.

Both live within a few short blocks of the center, and with the installation of a new screen and sound system in the gym at the VJCC, it was only natural for us to try to put on an event that showcased both "The Shokudo Series" and the center's new equipment. With the blessing and trust of the staff and Board of Directors at the VJCC, we charged forward with our vision of a new and unique event that emphasized immersing quests in a cultural

immersing guests in a cultural environment complete with the sights, sounds, smells, and tastes that characterize not only the "The Shokudo Series", but also the broader Japanese American community.

In the beer garden, Masa from Uka Sake would pour samples of premium sake as he explained to you the various varieties and flavors. You could also take a quick calligraphy lesson from Venice Shodo Kai or make a block print at the craft booth run by volunteers from the nearby Westlight Community Church.

Koshin Taiko, VJCC's taiko group, opened the main stage activities.








