

VJCC is looking for. <u>Senior Nutrition Manager/Liaison to the Board of Directors</u> (Volunteer)



Numerous booths also host their own booths in the Matsuri to reach out to the visiting community, have fun with the community in a different way than their normal activities, and at times learn new skills like serving Chili Bowls.

But what makes the Matsuri worth it year in and year out for Clubs and its members? Outside of seeing familiar faces, the Matsuri booths and demonstrations allow us to fundraise and market our club to potential new members. Several of the students and instructors in our club compete, take certifications, and attend seminars, and the Club utilizes the raised funds as scholarships for them to learn, be inspired, and help the club grow. The new members that join from the Matsuri are often families, helping our club reach the next generation and become not just a club, but a community.

We hope to be a part of the Natsu Matsuri for many many more years to come!
