A Message of Gratitude and Reflection from the 2023 Miss Western LA Queen by Aiko Dzikowski

When I first applied to the Miss Western LA and Nisei Week Queen and Court Programs, I had no idea how much my life would change in the months and years to follow. Having just moved to LA not even a year before applying, I remain so touched and grateful for everything the experience has given me: a community, a sisterhood and a family.

As a second and fourth generation Japanese American who grew up in a predominantly white town in Pennsylvania, I had always dreamed of having a Japanese American community. Now, all thanks to everyone involved with the Venice Japanese Community Center, the Venice West-LA JACL and Nisei Week, I feel like my dreams have come true. Because of the kindness and warmth I continue to receive from the inspiring people I have met through this program – including Kazie Kame, Delcene Kuwata, Irene Osako, John Saito, Shannon Tsumaki, and Faith Nishimura who gave me this opportunity - I am now determined to continue my involvement and to help support the next generation of Japanese American women and girls.

Alongside the six incredible women I am honored to call my sisters, I have been lucky enough to participate in leadership development workshops, cultural enrichment training, nearly a hundred local community events and life-changing trips to Japan,

Hawaii and San Francisco. I have grown not only as a public speaker and community leader, but also as a cultural ambassador, global citizen and friend. My sisters - from the 2023 Nisei Week court, previous Nisei Week courts and the Cherry Blossom Courts of Hawaii and Northern California inspire me to be the best, kindest, most authentic version of myself, and my favorite memories involve the moments we were able to share together.





As part of a greater sisterhood and within a big family which includes my newfound aunties and uncles, I am excited for the next chapter of my learning and growth as a Japanese American woman. While the women in my family have spent most of their lives in Japan, my grandmother was born in California and my mother lived in West LA for some of her childhood. As a homecoming of sorts, I am beyond honored to have reintegrated into and represented such a wonderful community over the course of the past year. I couldn't

> have done it without your tremendous support and my hope is that I will be able to help the community's next generation of queens to come. Thank vou.

Ikigai - The Art of Staying Young While **Growing Old**

I became a member of the VJCC to enroll my son **Josh** onto a **VYC SureShot** basketball team. Presently, Josh is a coach for his son Landon's basketball team, the Venice Sharks. Landon is 8 years old, Josh is older, and I am



trying to stay young while growing old. I've traded my books on basic basketball skills for books like IKIGAI - The Japanese Secret to a Long and Happy Life. The kanji for ikigai can be translated as a "lifeworthwhile."

The book focuses on the Okinawa Blue Zone which has the most centenarian citizens anywhere on the planet. In the book it states, *"Certain longevity studies suggest a strong sense of community"* and a clearly defined Ikigai are just as important as the famously healthful Japanese (Okinawan) diet, perhaps even more so..."

On August 17, the new **Bingo Committee** ran a hugely successful VJCC Bingo Night. The event saw the unveiling of the new and improved video projector/motorized screen/sound system. It's hard to see the return on investment (ROI) on audio-visual (AV) equipment for our community center; it's much easier to 'feel' the AV equipment's return on relationships (ROR). The investment in the AV equipment will help us continue to build "a strong sense of community" through videos featuring our multi-generational membership shown to all who attend our multi-generational VJCC events.



Club Representation at Oregon Summer Gasshuku





RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS OF CLASSES AND ORGANIZATIONS

- 1. Each participant, parent of a minor participant (child under the age of 18 years living at the same address, or a full-time student under the age of 24 years) and instructor must be a member of VJCC.
- 2. Each adult and minor participant must be covered by medical insurance.
- 3. Anyone suffering an injury must immediately report this to the instructor or responsible adult.
- 4. Each organization must have a responsible adult (instructor or organization officer) present during all practices, meetings or classes. If a responsible adult is not present, the class shall be cancelled.
- 5. The responsible adult shall have the authority to cancel all activities when the gym, classrooms or other facilities are found to be unsafe.
- 6. The responsible adult shall see that each participant is in only authorized areas of the building. Unauthorized areas are those areas that are not pertinent to the activities, such as the stage and the stairways of the gym, etc.
- 7. Each participant shall be responsible for leaving the room clean and in order.
- 8. As class or organization members, each participant is expected to help in VJCC-sponsored events (e.g., clean-up, festival, bingo, etc.).
- 9. This form must be completed annually.
